DIVISION BY CHOCOLATE

OBJECTIVE: To encourage trainees to meet more people and to form small groups that are not necessarily made up of their close co-workers or friends.

PROCEDURE: Place a bowl or bag of assorted miniature candy bars on each training table. The bowl should contain the same number of candy bars as participants seated at the table, for example if there are 10 seats per table there should be 10 candy bars in the bowl. Ask each student to pick his or her favorite candy bar from the bowl. After everyone has selected a treat, ask your trainees to sort themselves according to their candy bars. For example all Butterfingers sit at table one, all Milky Ways at table 2, etc. (Note: It is important that the total number of any one candy bar does not exceed the total number of seats at a table.)

MATERIALS REQUIRED: Bowls or bags, assorted candy bars.

APPROXIMATE TIME NEEDED: 5 – 10 minutes
