## **TENNIS BALL TOSS**

**OBJECTIVE:** To help participants to learn one another's names.

**PROCEDURE:** Instructor and participants stand in a circle. The instructor states her name and tosses a tennis ball to a participant. The participant states her name and tosses the ball to another participants, and so on. This continues until everyone has received and tossed the ball several times.

Then, the rules change. As players toss the ball, they say the recipient's name instead of their own. Continue until everyone has received and tossed the ball several times in this fashion.

The game always provides a few laughs while helping students and teacher alike to learn participants' names.

**MATERIALS REQUIRED:** Tennis or other ball

**APPROXIMATE TIME NEEDED:** 10 minutes
